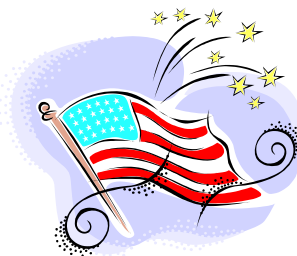
## President Resigns
